

**For P6 pupils****Key Events and Dates – Release of PSLE Results and Secondary School Posting Exercise**

<b>Key Event</b>	<b>Date</b>
Release of PSLE Results	Tentatively between 24 and 27 November 2017.
Submission of Options a. Via <b>S1 Internet System (S1-IS)</b>	7 calendar days starting from the release of PSLE results (e.g. if PSLE results are released on 24 November, options can be submitted from 24 to 30 November).  S1-IS is accessible 24 hours starting from 11am on the first day until 3pm on the last day of S1 Option Phase.
b. Via <b>Primary School</b>	5 working days starting from the release of PSLE results (e.g. if PSLE results are released on 24 November, options can be submitted from 24 November to 30 November). Primary schools will not be opened on weekends.  Submission starts from 11am to 3pm on the first day; and 9am to 3pm from the second to last day of S1 Option Phase.  For students who missed the one week period for submission of options, they can approach the primary schools for assistance the day after the submission closes, from 9am to 12pm. This half day submission is only for new submissions of S1 school choices and not for amendments to submitted options.
Release of S1 Posting Results	21 December 2017 (tentative)
Students to report to secondary schools for registration	22 December 2017 at 8.30am (tentative)

- On the day of the release of PSLE Results, students are to report to the school hall in their school uniform. The PSLE results would be released at **about 11am**. The students will also receive a **PSLE certificate** and **personalized S1 Option Form addressed to their parents/guardians**. The S1 Option Form contains a unique password (S1 PIN) for the parents/guardians to submit their child's/ward's choices of secondary schools.
- There are various avenues to check the Sec 1 Posting Results:
  - Online or via the telephone system: Students need not come to school.
  - For students who are coming to school to check the posting results, they are to report to the school **in their school uniform** at noon.
- All students must report to the secondary schools they have been posted to on **Friday, 22 December at 8.30am** (tentative), even if they wish to appeal for a transfer. They have to be in their Coral Primary uniform when they report to their secondary schools.
