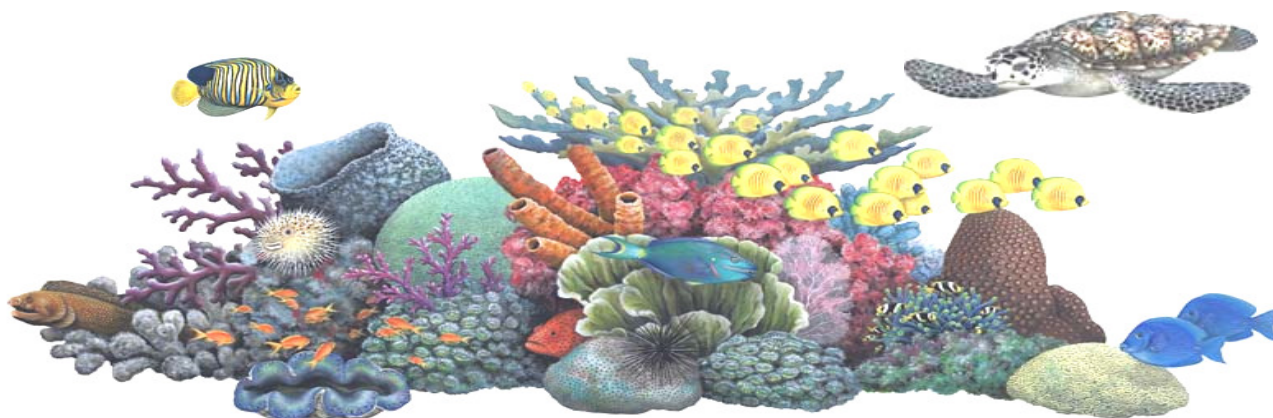

3. P1 & P2 Music Appreciation, Musical -Treasure Island at DBS Arts Centre, Friday, 06 November 2015

- 3.1 As part of music appreciation, the P1 and P2 students will be attending a musical, Treasure Island, staged by the Singapore Repertory Theatre's (SRT) The Little Company (TLC) at DBS Arts Centre on the 6 November.
- 3.2 School hours remain unchanged. Students are to be in their School Uniform. In addition, they are to bring the following items:

4. Cancellation of Outdoor Activities - P4 & P5 Road Safety Traffic Games and P6 Post-PSLE Learning Journeys

6. End-of-Year Parent-Teacher Meet (PTM), Tuesday, 17 November

6.1 PTM for P1 & P2

- 6.1.1 The End-of-Year PTM for P1 and P2 pupils will be held on **Tuesday, 17 November** from 8.00 a.m. to 3.00 p.m. in the respective classrooms. For this PTM, the pupils are required to attend the session together with their parents. As part of our efforts in developing Coralites into effective communicators, the pupils will be using this platform to share with their parents their school experiences and learning outcomes.
- 6.1.2 The P1 pupils will be sharing their first year in Coral Primary School. The P2 pupils will be reading aloud one of their stories they have written during their English Lessons.
- 6.1.3 Your appointment for the PTM will be indicated in the attached reply slip/acknowledgement form (Annex A). Your child/ward only needs to be in school with you during the appointed time. If you are unable to attend the meeting at the appointed time, please inform the Form Teacher to reschedule the appointment.

6.2 PTM for P3 – P5 Pupils

- 6.2.1 The End-of-Year PTM for P3 to P5 pupils will be held on **Tuesday, 17 November** from 2.30 p.m. to 5.30 p.m. in the School Hall. The Form Teacher will schedule a meeting with you if he/she needs to meet up with you. Your appointment for the PTM will be indicated in the attached reply slip/acknowledgement form (Annex A). If you are unable to attend the meeting at the appointed time, please inform the Form Teacher to reschedule the appointment.
- 6.2.2 For parents/guardians who are not required by the Form Teacher to attend the PTM, you may still indicate your request to meet up with the teachers in the reply slip/acknowledgement form (Annex A). The Form Teacher will then schedule a time slot and inform you.
